



MANHATTAN, Kan. – A fine dining steakhouse is set to elevate the Little Apple’s culinary landscape. Booth Creek Wagyu announced Wednesday that construction of a new restaurant, called The Garrison Room, will begin soon with plans to open next spring.

The steakhouse will source all of its beef from Booth Creek Wagyu, one of America’s leading Wagyu producers. Guests will enjoy a cozy and intimate environment that reflects the quality of the cuisine.

“Manhattan is a special community rooted in agriculture,” said Tyler Dreiling, managing partner of The Garrison Room. “This is a passion project that goes back years, and I couldn’t be more excited to see it finally come together.”

In addition to steaks, the restaurant will feature some classic beef-based entrees, including a signature burger, as well as a few seafood options. When available, some of the restaurant’s produce and other ingredients will be sourced locally.

Guests can look forward to a private dining room, bar, and membership opportunities with unique perks, including private tours of Booth Creek Wagyu Ranch. The steakhouse will be directly connected to a new meat market on McCall Road.

One of the project’s objectives is to provide Manhattan with more options for fine dining, which will benefit residents and visitors alike.

“The hospitable spirit here is incredible,” Dreiling said. “Coach Snyder came here for that reason, as he’s shared many times.

“To me, part of hospitality is providing more options, especially to visitors who want to experience Manhattan’s charm and culture. A steakhouse with local influence is a great way to achieve that goal.”

The restaurant’s name pays tribute to a farming town that was abandoned and submerged under Tuttle Creek Lake when the Big Blue River was dammed in 1952. Garrison, located near present-day Booth Creek Wagyu Ranch in Pottawatomie County, was founded in 1879 and had 400 residents at its peak.

“It’s a story not many people have heard,” Dreiling said. “We’re excited to share it, and I believe it adds character to what we’re building.”
